TENOROC RANGE SAFETY RULES AND REGULATION

- ALWAYS KEEP THE GUN POINTED IN A SAFE DIRECTION.
- ALWAYS KEEP YOUR FINGER OFF THE TRIGGER UNTIL READY TO SHOOT.
- ALWAYS KEEP THE ACTION OPEN AND FIREARM UNLOADED UNTIL READY TO USE.
- KNOW YOUR TARGET AND WHAT IS BEYOND.
- BE SURE THE GUN IS SAFE TO OPERATE.
- USE ONLY THE CORRECT AMMUNITION FOR YOUR GUN.
- WEAR EAR AND EYE PROTECTION.
- NEVER USE ALCOHOL OR DRUGS BEFORE OR WHILE SHOOTING.
- STORE GUNS SO THAT THEY ARE NOT ACCESSIBLE TO UNAUTHORIZED PERSONS.

GENERAL RANGE RULES AND REGULATIONS

Know & obey all range commands. **The Range Officer or TSST employees have the final authority for range safety.** If you observe an unsafe condition, immediately call "CEASE FIRE". Shoot only at authorized targets in your firing line. Targets are to be center on designated target holders only. All others in your firing lane should be laid down. **DO NOT SHOOT TARGET HOLDERS OR SIGNS.** Doing so will incur a 10\$ fine.

All actions must be open and the firearm unloaded, except when ready to shoot. All loading of firearms must be done on a designated firing line only with **maximum of 2 shells for shotguns.**

No, food, beverages, or tobacco products are allowed on any firing line.

Clean your area before departing. Trash receptacles are provided.

Shooting is allowed on designated ranges only.

There is NO RAPID FIRING at anytime on any range with no exceptions. A count of at least full seconds between each shot should be possible.

- Only one shooter and coach are allowed per shooting station **on all ranges.**
- Youths **MUST** stay with a parent or responsible adult.
- All patrons are responsible for reading and obeying all signs posted on ranges.
- Inexperience shooters must notify Range Officer and seek assistance.
- **Firearms are never handled when the line is declared safe. All persons must remain behind the RED line during safe periods, unless repairing targets. No one is permitted forward to the firing line until the line is declared safe by the Range Officer.**

No incendiary, tracer, or armor piercing ammunition. No exploding targets.

DO NOT SHOOT WILDLIFE.

When arriving on target range and appear to be alone, be certain that no other person is down range before firing. Alert new comers if you are down range.

In the event that a malfunction prevents you from clearing and/or unloading your firearm, do not remove the firearm from the firing line. Seek assistance from the Range Officer.

No foul language will be tolerated.

If you are in doubt of any procedure, please ask before proceeding.

REMEMBER: The Range Officer or TSST employee has the final authority.
